



CONSTRUCTION & ROAD CLOSURE ALERT

HEAVY CONSTRUCTION ON JERSEY AVENUE IN KINGS COUNTY

FRESNO, CALIF. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces heavy construction activity on Jersey Avenue in Kings County between 7th Avenue and 9th Avenue as part of the HSR overcrossings construction.

The work is scheduled to begin Monday, May 21, 2018 and is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.



Construction on Jersey Avenue will begin Tuesday, May 21, 2018, and is expected to continue through the end of the year.

There will be no road closures required.



Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Pedestrian access will also be restricted.

This schedule is subject to change. For up-to-date information please visit BuildHSR.com or the Caltrans Quickmap. Traffic laws will be fully enforced and commuters are expected to be aware of the surrounding activities, remain alert and watch for construction vehicles and personnel. The public is asked to drive carefully and be extra cautious while traveling through the construction areas.
