



CONSTRUCTION & ROAD CLOSURE ALERT

CONSTRUCTION ON DAVIS AVENUE IN FRESNO COUNTY

Issued: Jan. 17, 2018

FRESNO, CALIF. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces construction activity on Davis Avenue between Highway 43 and Fowler Avenue in Fresno County for utility relocation that will start on Feb. 21.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.



Construction at Davis Avenue between Highway 43 and Fowler Avenue will start on Feb. 21. Work is expected to continue through early March.

Closures will be required from Feb. 21 thru Feb. 28.



Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Pedestrian access will also be restricted.

This schedule is subject to change. For up-to-date information, please visit BuildHSR.com or the Caltrans Quickmap. Traffic laws will be fully enforced and commuters are expected to be aware of the surrounding activities, remain alert and watch for construction vehicles and personnel. The public is asked to drive carefully and be extra cautious while traveling through the construction areas.
