Intermittent Traffic Impacts Along State Route 43 In Kings County

Kings County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along State Route (SR) 43 in Kings County to transport embankment material to a high-speed rail construction site. Hauling is scheduled from 6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. starting Saturday, April 26 through Friday, May 16, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along SR 43 in Kings County to transport embankment material to a high-speed rail construction site.

Hauling is scheduled from 6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. starting Saturday, April 26 through Friday, May 16, 2025.

Haul Route

Embankment material will be hauled west across SR 43 to a high-speed rail construction site, north of Nevada Avenue.
