



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Road Closure Along Manning Avenue In Fresno County

Fresno County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces a road closure Manning Avenue, between Chance and Cedar avenues in Fresno County for ongoing work at a high-speed rail grade separation. Work is scheduled to begin Friday, April 25, 2025 and will continue through March 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Road closure Manning Avenue, between Chance and Cedar avenues in Fresno County for ongoing work at a high-speed rail grade separation.


Eastbound Traffic

Traffic going eastbound on Manning Avenue will be detoured north on Cedar Avenue, east on South Avenue, then south on Chestnut Avenue to Manning Avenue.

Westbound Traffic

Traffic going westbound on Manning Avenue will be detoured north on Chestnut Avenue, west on South Avenue then south on Cedar Avenue to Manning Avenue.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained for all property and business owners.



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
