Intermittent Lane Closures Along State Route 198 In Kings County

Kings County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent lane closures along State Route (SR) 198, between Sixth Avenue and SR 43 in Kings County for ongoing work at the Hanford Viaduct. Work is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Wednesday, June 11 and Thursday, June 12, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane closures along SR 198, between Sixth Avenue and SR 43 in Kings County for ongoing work at the Hanford Viaduct.

Work is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Wednesday, June 11 and Thursday, June 12, 2025.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Drivers may experience delays.
