Intermittent Traffic Impacts Along State Route 43 In Fresno County

Fresno County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along State Route (SR) 43, between Davis Avenue and Cole Slough in Fresno County for work on a high-speed rail structure. Work is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting Monday, Sept. 29 through Friday, Oct. 24, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along SR 43, between Davis Avenue and Cole Slough in Fresno County for work on a high-speed rail structure.

Work is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting Monday, Sept. 29 through Friday, Oct. 24, 2025.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic.
